The Crown Inn The Proposal

- The Parish Council is to purchase the premises
 - Funded by:
 - Public Works Loan Board loan
 - Community Asset Fund grant
 - Tenancy
 - The council will appoint financially robust tenants to operate the business with the selection process focussed on finding candidates capable of running the bar, restaurant and B&B.

- Public Works Loan Board Loan
 - Up to £300k over 25 years
 - Payments to be made twice yearly, funded by rental income
 - Reserve fund to be generated via precept (council tax) at an additional £83 for one year.
- Community Asset Fund
 - Grant applied for to cover 80% of purchase and other costs
 - Reduces PWLB amount to £60k
 - Reduces increase in precept to £17 for one year

The Crown Inn Funding

Vacancy

- Funding Manager
 - To complete application forms
 - To prepare a business plan
 - To progress the bid

- As owners, the parish council will be responsible for the cost of maintaining the building and its assets.
 - Funded through rental income
- Tenants are responsible for all 'operational' costs.
- Development and improvements to be funded by 'The Friends of The Crown'.
 A fund-raising group to be established.

The Crown Inn Maintenance

The Friends of The Crown

- The 'Friends of The Crown' an independent, voluntary group, to be formed to assist the Parish Council in raising funds for the development and maintenance of The Crown Inn. To identify projects to enhance and improve the premises for the benefit of the community and customers of the pub.

 - Furnishings
 - Secondary glazing
 - Repairs
